About the Workshop

In this workshop Anne will guide you through several techniques used to produce a watercolour painting from direct observation of a still life. Paying attention to tone, Anne will help you gain confidence when handling and mixing colour, exploring how to modify colours to enhance and subdue elements of your composition.

This workshop is suitable for complete beginners to competent practitioners, and Anne will provide plenty of support throughout the day. All that is needed is a willingness to explore!

Morning

- Introduction
- Anne will lead a series of short exercises exploring tone with colour

Afternoon

- Break for lunch
- Using the observation of the morning exercises, you will develop a larger scaled work either directly from a still life or exploring an abstraction from your discoveries
- Review: final round up and viewing of the work as a group and a chance to discuss and consider a way forward for individuals

About the Tutor

Anne Lynch, born in Edinburgh, studied at Edinburgh Art College then moved to London where she now has a studio, and another in France. She has always worked in watercolour and uses collage to sustain the mark and luminosity.

She won the Purchase Prize at the RWS Contemporary Watercolour Exhibition in 2017, the Art Critic Award in the RI at the Mall Galleries in 2018 and was shortlisted for the Drawing Bursary Discerning Eye exhibition in 2014.

Anne teaches students ranging from beginners to advanced. She has taught for 18 years part time on a degree course and over 30 years with many adult and private courses.

- **A5 or A6 200gsm watercolour paper**
- **A4 or A3 300gsm watercolour paper**
- **Sketchbook** (if you prefer to work in these)
- **Watercolour set** – pans or tubes
- **Selection of watercolour paint brushes**
- **Glue stick or pritt stick**
- **Water container and mixing palette or plate**
- **pencil & eraser**
